hook: USM/N/9mm

10*10cm (4*4") = 6 stitches * 9 rows in Single crochet

Pattern Instructions

Head

Row 1

6sc in mr (6)

Row 2

Inc 6sc (12)

Row 3

Sc, inc (18)

Row 4

2sc, inc (24)

Row 5

3sc, inc (30)

Row 6

4sc, inc (36)

Row 7

5sc, inc (42)

Row 8

6sc, inc (48)

From row 8 to 12:

Sc in every stich (48)

Place safty eyes size of your choice between riw 10 and 11.

Row 13

6sc, dec (42)

Row 14

5sc, dec (36)

End of head do not finish off.

Stuff head most of the way full.

Tentacles

Row 15

[2sc, in next stich chain 40] 8 Inc in every chain (24)

When you return to your first stich sl into the origan stich that you made your chains in.

If your right handed twist tentacles clock wise and if your left handed swist counter clockwise.

Closing up



Embroider face and eyelashes

Congradulations your octopus is done.

Flip the octopus upside down and mive the tentacles out of the way and finish stuffing.

Row 16

[2Sc, sl into the stich after tentacle] 8 (16)

Row 17

2sc, dec (8)

Row 18

Sc, dec (4)

Row 19

Dec (0)

SI to finish off
