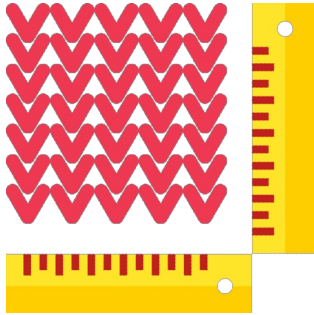

Yarn over

Dc

To DC, yarn over and pull through chain. You should have 3 loops on your hook. Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on your hook. Yarn over again and pull through the 2 remaining loops on your hook, one dc has been made.



Pattern Instructions







From row 1 to 66:

RIBBING

To begin ch 6

Row 1: 6 hdc on the beginning ch, ch1(ch 1 does not count as stitch) and turn

Row 2: 6hdc on bkl ch1 turn

Row 3 - row 66 : 6hdc on bkl , ch 1 turn.

After 66 rows join with a sl st.

N/B: the ribbing should be 40cm/ 16 inches long

From row 1 to 13:

OVERALLS(BOTTOM)

Row 1: sc all around one edge of the ribbing(80sc)

Row 2- Row 4: 1 dc in each st(80dc)

Row 5: 1 dc in each st back loop only(80dc)

Row 6- Row 12: 1dc in each st(80dc)

Row 13: mark 10st at the middle of your project(both front and back)

From row 14 to 28:

LEG HOLES RIBBING

Row 14: join the 10dc at the front to the 5dc at the back with a sl st.

Row 15: sc over the leg holes then ch 9, skip 2st and sl st twice the turn

Row 16 - till the end of the leg hole: 1sc in each st back loop only(8sc) ch 1 turn

Row 17: 1sc in each st bkl only, sl st twice

Repeat row 16 and 17 till you cover the leg hole the join with a sl st.

Do the same for the other leg hole

From row 1 to 16:

OVERALLS (TOP)

ROW 1: (worked on row 5 where we did dc on the front loop only) mark 30 st and join your yarn. Make 1 dc in each st(30dc) ch1 and turn

Row 2 -row 4: make 1 dc in each stitch, ch 1 and turn

Row 5- row 8: make 1 dec at the beg of the row and 1 at the end of the row(To decrease work the first dc until only two loops remain on your hook, yarn over and place your hook in next st. Yarn over pull through st, yarn over pull through 2 loops. Yarn over pull yarn through all 3 loops) and 1dc in each of the remaining st (78dc) ch 1 and turn

Row 9- row 17: place 1dc in each st, ch 1 and turn(72dc)

From row 1 to 22:

STRAPS

Row 1: join yarn at one end of the ribbing at the back , and place 1 dc in each st for the next 5st, ch 1 and turn(5dc)

Row 2- row 22: place 5dc in each st, ch 1 and turn.

You can sew in buttons at the front of your overalls like i did (for easier adjustment)or join it with a slip stitch
