



Grandma's Dishcloths

This is my grandma's pattern for her dishcloths. She's been making them for years, and I found the original pattern in a chest she gave me. I wanted to share it with the rest of the community so it wouldn't be forgotten, and so anyone else can make a few of their own.

Pattern informations



Material



Yarn:

1 skein
1 skein



Needles:

straight: US8 /5mm
straight: US9 /5.5mm



Glossary

K2tog

Knit 2 stitches together

yo (ou) yon

Yarn over



Pattern Instructions



Materials: 1 skein of 100% cotton, makes 2 dishcloths

Needle size needed: 8 or 9 (5mm-5.5mm)

Note: this pattern can be used with any yarn and needles you'd like to use. This is just the standard pattern my grandma wrote down. Happy knitting :)

Cast on 4 stitches

Row 1

K4

Row 2

K2, inc in next st, K1 (should have 5 stitches now)

Row 3

K3, inc in next stitch, K1 (should have 6 stitches now)

Row 4

K3, yo, knit to end

Repeat row 4 until there is 48 stitches

Decrease row: K2, K2tog, yo, K2tog, knit to end

Repeat decrease row until 8 stitches on needle

Next row: K2, K2tog, K2tog, K2 (should have 6 stitches now)

Next row: K1, K2tog, K2tog, K1 (should have 4 stitches now)

Bind off at 4 stitches
