Teddy Bear Amigurumi

I always work in rounds, so I recommend using a stitch marker to keep track of your rows. Sorry for any mistakes, English isn't my first language

Pattern informations



Material



Yarn:

Brown DK or worsted cotton yarn, 4 skeins Cream DK or worsted cotton yarn, 1 skein



hook: USC/2.75mm

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repeat instructions from the single asterix as directed

inc (ou) incr Increase

sl st Slip stitch

SC Single crochet

INC Increase (2 SC in same stitch)

DIM Diminution or decrease



Pattern Instructions



Nose/Mouth

Nose/Mouth

Round 1: In a magic circle, 6 SC. Round 2: SC INC in each around. (12) Round 3: SC INC, SC INC, SC INC, SC in next 3. Repeat around (18) Round 4: SC, SC INC, SC, SC INC, SC, SC INC, SC in next 3. Repeat around. (24) Round 5: SC in first 2, SC INC, SC in first 2, SC INC, SC in first 2, SC INC, SC in next 3. Repeat around. (30) Round 6: SC in first 3, SC INC, SC in next 3, SC INC, SC in next 3, SC INC, SC in next 3. Repeat around. (36) Rounds 7-8: SC in each around. (36)

Slip stitch in the next 3 stitches. Fasten off and leave a long tail to sew on to the face.

Get a long piece of brown yarn. Sew the nose on about row 6. I make multiple passes (think 10-12) for this bear's nose. Try to use the same two holes when you go in and out. Use pins to attach it. For this bear, the snout will be more flat than full. Sew it around and very lightly stuff it.



Body and head

Round 1: In a magic circle, 6 SC. Round 2: SC INC in each around. (12) Round 3: *INC, 1 SC. (18) Round 4: *1 SC, INC, 1 SC. (24) Round 5: *INC, 3 SC. (30) Round 6: *2 SC, INC, 2 SC. (36) Round 7: *INC, 5 SC. (42) Round 8: *3 SC, INC, 3 SC. (48) Round 9: *INC, 7 SC. (54)

Rounds 10-20: SC in each around. (54)

Round 21: *DIM, 7 SC (48) Rounds 22-23: SC in each around. (48) Round 24: *3 SC, DIM, 3 SC. (42) Rounds 25-26: SC in each around. (42) Round 27: *DIM, 5 SC. (36) Round 28: SC in each around. (36) Round 29: *2 SC, DIM, 2 SC. (30) Round 30-31: SC in each around. (30)

Begin stuffing here. Make sure you do not under-stuff.

Round 32: *DIM, 3 SC. (24) Round 33: *1 SC, DIM, 1 SC. (18)

From here we are increasing the head.

Round 34: *1 SC, INC, 1 SC. (24) Round 35: *INC, 3 SC. (30) Round 36: *2 SC, INC, 2 SC. (36) Round 37: *INC, 5 SC. (42) Round 38: *3 SC, INC, 3 SC. (48) Round 39: *INC, 7 SC. (54) Round 40: *4 SC, INC, 4 SC. (60) Round 41: *INC, 9 SC. (66)

Rounds 42-53: SC in each around. (66)

Round 54: *DIM, 9 SC. (60) Round 55: *4 SC, DIM, 4 SC. (54) Round 56: *DIM, 7 SC. (48) Round 57: *3 SC, DIM, 3 SC. (42) Round 58: *DIM, 5 SC. (36) Round 59: *2 SC, DIM, 2 SC. (30)

Attach eyes between rows 47 and 48, about 6 stitches apart. Begin to stuff here. I also stretch the base of the head a little bit so it is more defined, more round than oval. Sew on the nose at this time as well.

Round 60: *DIM, 3 SC. (24) Round 61: *1 SC, DIM, 1 SC. (18) Round 62: *DIM, 1 SC. (12) Round 63: *DIM in each around. (6)

Fasten off and carefully sew the remaining hole closed.



Arms (2)

Make 2 arms.

Round 1: In a magic circle, 6 SC. (6) Round 2: SC INC in each around. (12) Round 3: *INC, 1 SC. (18) Round 4: *1 SC, INC, 1 SC. (24) Round 5-9: SC in each around. (24) Round 10: 4 DIM, SC in remaining around. (20) Round 11: 2 DIM, SC in remaining around. (18) Rounds 12-26: SC in each around. (18) Round 27: *2 SC, DIM, 2 SC. (15) Rounds 28-29: SC in each around. (15) Round 30: *DIM, 3 SC. (12) Round 31: SC in each around. (12)







Make 2 legs.

Start with cream yarn. Round 1: In a magic circle, 6 SC. (6) Round 2: SC INC in each around. (12) Round 3: *INC, 1 SC. (18) Round 4: *1 SC, INC, 1 SC. (24) Round 5: *INC, 3 SC. (30) Round 6: *2 SC, INC, 2 SC. (36)

On round 7, I am changing yarn color. The way I prefer to do it (see image) is: Yarn over cream yarn. You then have 2 loops on your hook. Then yarn over brown yarn. Repeat in next stitch.

Rounds 7-12: SC in each around. (36) Round 13: 8 DIM, SC in the remaining stitches. (28) Round 14: SC in each around. (28) Round 15: 4 DIM, SC in the remaining stitches. (24) Rounds 16-30: SC in each around. (24)

Round 31: *3 SC, DIM, 3 SC. (21) Round 32: SC in each around. (21) Round 33: *DIM, 5 SC. (18) Round 34: SC in each around. (18)

Round 31: *1 SC, DIM, 1 SC. (18) Round 32-34: SC in each around. (18) Round 35: *DIM, 1 SC. (12)



Make 2 ears.

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Round 1: In a magic circle, 6 SC. (6) Round 2: SC INC in each around. (12) Round 3: *INC, 1 SC. (18) Round 4: *1 SC, INC, 1 SC. (24) Round 5: *INC, 3 SC. (30) Rounds 6-8: SC in each around. (30)

Cut yarn and fasten off. Leave long tail to sew. Fold in 2 to create an ear

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Sewing everything together

When you sew the parts on the body/head, I recommend using pins to make sure everything is where you eant and it stays in place when you start sewing.

Sew the mouth on the head. With black yarn, create a nose. Then create the brows to give expression to your teddy bear.

Sew the ears.

Sew the legs and the arms.
