Size: dog One Size



Cute dog snood shown on a dachshund. For other small dog breeds that have shorter necks, I recommend using less chain stitches on the first row to make it shorter. Also, for larger dogs more rows can be added for the main part to be larger around.

Pattern Instructions



Bear ears (brown part) *make two of these

Row 1

Make magic circle, 6sc in magic circle.

Pull on yarn to tighten circle

Row 2

Ch1 place 2sc in each stitch

Bear ears (tan part) *make two of these

Row 1

Magic circle, 6sc in magic circle.

Sew the tan piece onto the brown piece using the back loops of the tan piece.

Sew ears to main piece 1.5in away from eachother and 1in from the edge of the main piece.

Main piece

Row 1

Ch 26

Row 2

1 sc in each stitch till end of row.

From row 3 to 24:

Ch 1, turn work, 1sc in the back loop of each stitch on thos row.

Row 25

Fold work in half longways so the first and last tow match up. Slip stitch the two sides together

Sew ears to main piece 1.5in away from eachother and 1in from the edge of the main piece.
