



Easter Egg Kinder

Size: other S



Decorative eggs that are sized to fit around a Kinder Joy egg. You can upcycle empty Kinder Joy eggs and use them as a filler using this pattern. If you do not have such eggs to your disposal, it is perfectly fine to use regular filler.

Yarn:

Microfibre, Nako, 1 skein



Needles:

hook: USC/2.75mm



Techniques

sc

Single crochet

hdc

Half double crochet

hdc inc

2 half double crochets in one stitch

dc

Double crochet

dc inc

2 double crochets in one stitch

slst

Slip stitch



Pattern Instructions



*One half (x
2)*

Row 1

14 ch

Row 2

[28] 2 sc, 9 hdc, 1 hdc inc, 1 hdc, 1hdc inc, 8 hdc, 3 sc, slst

Row 3

[30] 1 ch, in same stitch 1 sc, 2 sc, 3 hdc, 5 dc, 1 dc inc, 3 dc, 1 dc inc, 5 dc, 3 hdc, 4 sc

Row 4

[36] 5 slst, 3 sc, 4 hdc, (1 dc inc)*3, 1 dc, (1 dc inc)*3, 4 hdc, 3 sc, 4 slst

From this row on work on BLO

Row 5

[36] 1 ch, hdc in same stitch as the slip stitch and all remaining stitches of the row

Row 6

[40] 1ch, in same stitch as the slip stitch 1 hdc, 11 hdc, 1 hdc inc, 1 hdc, 1 hdc inc, 6 hdc, 1 hdc inc, 1 hdc, 1 hdc inc, 12 hdc, slst

Row 7

[42] 2 ch, in the same stitch 1 dc, 12 dc, 1 dc inc, 13 dc, 1 dc inc, 13 dc, slst

Row 8

[42] 1 ch, hdc in same stitch and in all stitches of the row, slst to the first stitch of this row and finish off



Joining

After you finish making two parts, connect them using slip stitches over each cross stitch on the edges. Start joining from the bottom, wider part of the egg to hide the closing better. You can use different coloured yarn to join or the same colour as the body of egg.



Decorating the body



Since we used BLO after row 4, you can use different coloured yarn to make slip stitches over the front loops. You can also sew beads over the front loops or the entire body - your imagination is the limit to decorate the eggs :)
