Techniques

Working in the round

This pattern is worked in the round unless otherwise stated.

Size

If you want the ghost a different size you will need to adjust the size of the hook

Invisible dec

I use the invisible decrease, but regular decreases will be just fine.



Pattern Instructions



Body



Row 1

Make a MC: HDC 8 in the circle = 8 stitches

Row 2

HDC inc in each stitch = 16sts

Row 3

1 HDC, 1 HDC inc = 24 sts

Row 4

HDC in each st = 24 sts

Row 5

2 HDC, 1 HDC inc = 32 sts

Row 6

3 hdc, 1hdc inc = 40 sts

Row 7

hdc in each st = 40 sts

Row 8

4 hdc, 1hdc inc, 3 hdc = 48 sts

Row 9

5 hdc, 1 hdc inc, 3 hdc = 56 sts

Row 10

hdc in each st = 56 sts

Row 11

hdc in the first 14 sts, ch 6, skp nxt 6 sts, slp st in tje nct st, hdc in the nxt 14 sts, ch 6, skp nxt 6 sts, slo st in the mxt st, hdc in the last 14 sts = 54 sts

Row 12

hdc in the 1st 14 sts, hdc in ea of the ch 6 sts, hdc in the nxt 14 sts, hdc in ea of the ch 6 sts, hdc in the last 14 sts = 54 sts

From row 13 to 20:

hdc in ea st = 54

Row 21

Slp st to join, ch 3, 3 dc in each st = 163 sts. Fasten off and weave in tail.

Body



Arms and Hands



Row 1

Attach yarn to the bottom right corner of either arm hole, slp st and hdc in the same st, hdc in ea st = 15 sts

From row 2 to 3:

hdc in each st = 15 sts

Row 4

1 hdc, 1hdc inc = 22 sts

Row 5

2 hdc, 1 hdc inc in the 1st 16 sts, hdc in the last 10 sts = 26 sts do not cut yarn. You will be going straight into doing the hand from here. The hand will start back with row 1 under the hand section.

Row 6

This row will be completed after the hand is made. You can refer back to this section or just follow the pattern in row 4 of the hand. Please continue on the the hand section. Attach yarn in the same place you finished off on row 5 of the arm (sleeve) slp st , sc in each st = 26 sts



Hands



Row 1

Slp st, ch 5, turn and skp 5 sts, slp st in the nxt st (this makes the circle for the hand). Turn

Row 2

Sc in the BLO if the nxt 5 sts, turn sc in each if the ch 5 sts = 10sts

Row 3

Sc in the 1st st (place stitch marker in this st), sc dec in the nxt st = 7 sts

Row 4

2 sc, 1sc dec, 2 sc = 6 sts fasten off, leave a long tail for closing the hand and sewing to the pumpkin. From here attach yarn to row 6 of the arm (sleeve) to finish off the arm or end if the sleeve. ROW 6. Slp st and sc in ea st = 26 sts. Also you can go ahead now and place the eyes over rows 3,5 and 6 with 5 to 6 sts in between. It will be easier to do the eyes now rather than wait till after you place the form inside the head you can either embroider the eyes or place safety eyes. The white eye shine is optional.



Inside head form



Row 1

Make MC 8 sc in the circle = 8 sts

Row 2

Sc inc in each st = 16 sts

Row 3

1 sc, 1 sc inc = 24 sts

Row 4

2sc, 1sc inc = 32 sts

From row 5 to 12:

Sc in each st = 32 sts

Row 13

2 sc, 1 sc dec = 24 sts

Row 14

1sc, 1sc dec = 16 sts stuff

Row 15

8 sc dec = 8 sts

Row 16

4 sc = 4 sts fasten off leave long tail to close shut and to sew the ball to inside of the head using a tapestry needle. Optional: if you want your ghost to be able to hang like an ornament, leave the tail extra long to create the loop for hanging.



Pumpkin



Row 1

Make MC 6 sc in the circle = 6 sts

Row 2

Sc inc in each st = 12 sts

Row 3

1sc, 1 sc inc = 18 sts

Row 4

2sc, 1 sc inc = 24 sts

Row 5

3 sc , 1 sc inc = 30 sts

Row 6

4sc , 1 sc inc = 36 sts

From row 7 to 12:

Sc in each st = 36 sts

Row 13

4sc, 1sc dec = 30 sts

Row 14

3 sc, 1sc dec = 24 sts

Row 15

2sc, 1sc dec = 18 sts

Row 16

1sc, 1sc dec = 12 sts

Row 17

6 sc dec in each st, fasten off leave a tail approx 20" long. This will make the lines for the pumpkin, weave in and out to close the bottom of the pumpkin. Weave the tail from bottom to top wrapping the yarn placing the lines where you want them. Fasten off weave in tail. NOTE: If you want a smaller pumpkin suze down in your hook size.



Witch Hat

Row 1

MC 4 sc in circle = 4 sts

Row 2

4 sc = 4 sts

Row 3

1sc inc in ea st = 8 sts

Row 4

1sc in ea = 8 sts

Row 5

2sc, 1 sc inc = 16 sts

Row 6

1sc in ea = 16 sts

Row 7

3 sc, 1 sc inc = 20 sts

Row 8

1 sc in ea = 20 sts

Row 9

4 sc, 1 sc inc = 24 sts

Row 10

1 sc in ea = 24 sts

Row 11

5 sc, 1 sc inc = 28 sts

Row 12

Sc in ea = 28 sts

Row 13

6 sc, 1sc inc = 32 sts

Row 14

Sc in ea = 32 sts

Row 15

Ch 2, hdc inc in FLO of ea st = 64 sts

Row 16

Slp st to the 1st hdc, ch 2, hdc in ea st = 64 fasten off leave tail to swe to head.



Hat band

Row 1

Attach yarn between rows 12 & 13, pull through to the outside and slp st in each st making a chain = 28 sts. Attach hat in desired position on the head, if you made a loop for hanging and it is going to be under the hat make sure you pull it through the hat before sewing the hat in place. Sew that to the head using the BLO sts. Fasten off weave in tail



Assembly

With the tails on the hands run 1 one side through the center of the pumpkin to the other side, take the other tail and tie a knot. Take both tails and run back through the center of the pumpkin. If your tails are long enough, you can run them back-and-forth several times to make the pumpkin more secure. If you have any left over, you can use that piece and go through the backside of the center pumpkin, and attach it to the body. If you don't have enough left over, just add a new piece and attach it to the inside of the body and go back through the center of the pumpkin, and that will secure the pumpkin where it will not

rotate.

Place the hat on the head and your desired position. Note: if you made the loop to hang your ghost and your hat is going to be over that loop, make sure to pull the loop through the hat before you attach the hat. Using the tail from the hat, go through the back loop only loops and attach to the head. Note: if you want to stuff your hat do it before sew all the way around. Weave in the ends
