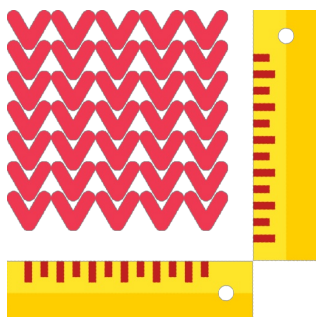


Needles:

Pattern Instructions



Cuff

Cast on 48 stitches using long tail method.

Round 1 to 10: K1, P1, repeat around



Leg

Round 1: K1, P3, repeat around

Round 2: K2, P2, repeat around

Round 3: K3, P1, repeat around

Round 4: K all, repeat around

Continue this pattern until you have completed 9 rounds of each (total of 36 rounds).

For the rest of the piece, use these 4 rows as the 'pattern'.



Heel

Row 1

Sl1, K1, repeat for 24 stitches, turn.

Row 2

Sl1, P across

Repeat each row 15 times (30 rows total).



Heel

Turn

Row 1

Sl1, K14, SSK, K1, turn

Row 2

Sl1, P7, P2tog, P1, turn

Row 3

Sl1, Knit to 1 stitch before gap, SSK, K1, turn

Row 4

Sl1, Purl to 1 stitch before gap, P2tog, P1, turn

Repeat row 3 & 4 until all stitches in section worked, and the outside your work is facing inwards (as it was when you began the piece).



Gusset

Start by knitting across all the stitches you've just been working, and place a stitch marker on your needle.

Pick up the 15 gusset stitches (either using the loop or a separate needle) and knit them in.

Add another marker.

Knit in pattern (starting with K1, P3 this row) until you get to the next lot of gusset stitches.

Place a marker.

Pick up the 15 gusset stitches (either using the loop or a separate needle) and knit them in.

Add another marker.

From now on, your ROUNDS start at the beginning of the plain knit half.



Foot

To close the gusset, you need to work 4 sections, which you should have separated with the stitch markers.

- 1- plain knit section
- 2- first gusset
- 3- pattern section
- 4- second gusset

1- knit across to the marker

2- K1, SSK, Knit to 3 stitches before marker, SSK, K1

3- Work in pattern (this time should be K2, P2) to the next marker

4- K1, SSK, Knit to 3 stitches before marker, SSK, K1

Continue this way until you arrive back at your starting stitch amount.

Once done, remove the stitch markers between the gusset sections and the knit sections.

Work the knit and pattern sections until you reach 120 of each pattern row (starting from the row you worked when attaching the gusset).



Toe

Round 1- K1, SSK, Knit to 3 before section marker, K2tog, K1, repeat on second section

Round 2- K all stitches

Repeat until you have 10 stitches left in each section.

Close with Kitchener stitch, weave in all ends, block as desired.
