# **Pattern informations**

## **Pattern instructions**

#### **Amigurumi Owl**

Body

**Row 1** 6 sc in magic ring

**Row 2** Inc x6 (12 sts)

Row 3 Inc, sc around (18 sts)

Row 4 Inc, 2 sc around (24 sts)

Row 5 Inc, 3 sc around (30 sts)

Row 6 Inc, 4 sc around (36 sts)

From row 7 to 18: Sc around (36 sts)

Row 19 Dec, 4 sc around (30 sts)

Row 20 Dec, 3 sc around (24 sts)

**Row 21** Dec, 2 sc (18 sts)

Row 22 Dec, 1 sc around (12 sts) Stuff body

**Row 23** Dec x 6 (6 sts) fasten off & weave in ends.

Eyes

Make 2 with white yarn

**Row 1** 6 sc in magic ring

Row 2 Inc around (12 sts)

Row 3 Inc, sc around (18 sts) Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Cut a strand of black yarn and sew a diagonal eyelid across each eye, knot off ends in the back.

Wings

Make 2

**Row 1** 6 sc in magic ring

Row 2

Inc x6 (12 sts)

#### Row 3

Inc, sc around (18 sts) Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Ears

Make 2

#### Row 1

3 sc in magic ring

#### Row 2

Inc x3 (6 sts) Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew eyes onto the body.

Fold each wing through the center to make them look like semi-circles, Sew them onto the sides of the body, near the bottom corner of each eye.

Cut a strand of cyan yarn and sew a series of upside-down Vs on the body, below the eyes. There should be 3 on the first row, 2 on the second, and 1 at the bottom. Sew ears onto the top of the head.

Cut out a small egg-shaped beak from the yellow felt seal. Cut it in half through the center. Glue it onto the point where both eyes meet.

Glue pink brads to the bottom corners of each eye. Tada!
