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Amigurumi Lemon

Yarn:

Any DK yarn , , 1 skeins

Any DK yarn , , 1 skeins

Needles:

hook: US000/3mm

DC

Double crochet (US single crochet)

2DCtog

Double crochet 2 stitches together in order to decrease (US sc2tog)

Indicates a repeat

SS

Slip stitch

HTC

Half treble crochet (US half double crochet)

TC

Treble crochet (US double crochet)

FO

Fasten off

Pattern instructions

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You have to crochet this cute little fella!

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You will need:

- 1) DK yarn in your chosen lemon colour.
- 2) Scraps of green DK yarn for the leaf.
- 3) A 3mm crochet hook.
- 4) A stitch marker.
- 5) Some stuffing.
- 6) Black 4mm beads for the eyes. You can also use safety eyes or scraps of black yarn if you want too!
- 7) Pink felt for the cheeks, you can either glue these on or alternatively you can sew them on with some matching thread.
- 8) Needle and black thread if you are using sew on eyes and for the mouth.
- 9) Darning needle.



Lemon body

Starting with the yellow yarn, Mark the beginning of each round with your stitch marker.

First, do Magic ring 6 stitches.

From row 1 to 2:

1DC all the way around (6)

Row 3

DC in each stitch all the way around (12)

Row 4

1DC all the way around (12)

Row 5

1DC, 2DC*(18)

Row 6

1DC all the way around (18)

Row 7

1DC, 1DC, 2DC* (24)

Row 8

1DC all the way around (24)

Row 9

1DC, 1DC, 1DC, 2DC* (30)

From row 10 to 13:

1DC all the way around (30)

Row 14

1DC, 1DC, 1DC, 2DCtog* (24)

Row 15

1DC all the way around (24)

Row 16

1DC, 1DC, 2DCtog* (18)

START STUFFING AT THIS POINT, INSTALL SAFETY EYES IF USING THEM.

Row 17

1DC all the way around (18)

Row 18

1DC, 2DCtog* (12)

Row 19

1DC all the way around (12)

Row 20

2DCtog all the way around (6)

From row 21 to 22:

1DC all the way around (6)

FO leaving a tail to sew the opening closed. Using your darning needle, run the tail of the yarn through the 6 remaining stitches.

I find it looks neatest if you pull the yarn through just one leg of the stitch and then pull them all together at the end. Secure your yarn and pass it through the item to finish cut off the excess.



Lemon leaf

Take your green yarn and chain 7.

The stitches in the chain each have 2 'legs' to make a leaf you need to work a stitch into each leg of the chain so you end up with a series of stitches on each side of the chain.

Skip first chain leg,

1DC, 1HTC, 1TC, 1TC, 1HTC, 1DC, CH1.

Turn your work so the un worked side of the chain is at the top, and continue around.

1DC, 1HTC, 1TC, 1TC, 1HTC, 1DC, SS into the top of the chain, cut yarn and fasten off.

You'll be left with two tails one at each end of the leaf, pick which end is to be the tip of the leaf and weave in the tail, cutting the excess.

Use the other tail to attach to the lemon. Weave in your tail and your done!

At this point you can choose to add features such as eyes, cheeks and mouth.

And you're done!

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
