Pattern informations



Material



Yarn:

Tan - This Sand is Your Sand, Woobles
Easy Peasy Yarn , 1 skein, color: ●
Dark Brown - Chocolate Moose,
Woobles Easy Peasy Yarn , 1 skein,
color: ●
Black - The Coal Shebang, Woobles
Easy Peasy Yarn , 1 skein, color: ●



Needles:

hook: USG/4mm

Pattern Instructions



Head and Body



With tan yarn.

Row 1

Start 6 sc in magic loop (6)

Row 2

6 inc (12)

Row 3

[sc, inc] x 6 (18)

Row 4

[inc, 2 sc] x 6 (24)

Row 5

24 sc (24)

Row 6

[5 sc, inc] x4 (28)

From row 7 to 9:

28 sc (28)

Row 10

[6 sc, inc] x4 (32)

From row 11 to 13:

32 sc (32)

Row 14

[2 sc, dec] x8 (16)

Row 15

24 sc (24)

Row 16

[sc, dec] x8 (16)

Row 17

16 sc (16)

Attach the eyes between rounds 7 and 8 with a 6-stitch space between them. Stuff the piece.

Row 18

8 dec (8)

Fasten off leaving a long tail. Thread a needle with the tail. Use it to pull the yarn tail through the front loops of each stitch. Pull tight to close the remaining gap.



Snout



With dark brown and black yarn.

This is an oval, but with different stitches to create a V shape.

Row 1

ch 8 (8)

Row 2

3 sc, [3 sc in the same stitch], 2 sc, [3 sc in the same stitch].
Rotate the piece to work on the other side of the foundation chain. 5 sc, inc in the very first ch. Sl st in the first sc of round 2 (18)

Invisible fasten off leaving a long tail. The snout should look like a V. Sew it so the V looks like it's upside-down, in the middle of the eyes, spanning rounds 8 to 11.

Thread a needle with an arm's length of black yarn. Use it to embroider a nose and mouth. The nose should be one round down from the top edge of the snout. The bottom of the vertical line should be at the bottom of the snout.



Ears

With dark brown yarn (make two).

Row 1

Start 6 sc in magic loop (6)

Row 2

6 inc (12)

From row 3 to 4:

12 sc (12)

Row 5

[sc, dec] x4 (8)

Row 6

8 sc (8)

Invisible fasten off leaving a long tail. Flatten the ear and whip stitch the two sides together. Sew the ears on the sides of the pug in between rounds 4 and 5.
