



Granny Square Water Bottle Holder

Needles:

hook: USJ/6mm

Pattern Instructions



Start with yellow for the center of the daisy slip stich and make a magic ring.

Row 1

Chain 3. Then Make 11 double crochets into the magic ring. The chain 3 will count as a dc as well. (12 dc total)

Insert hook in the top of the 3 chains. Make a slip stich, chain one, then cut the yarn and pull the tail through.

Now take the white yarn and make a slip stich to start making the petals for the daisy.

Row 1

Yarn over with white then insert hook into the yellow circle and make a double crochet. Make another 4 dc into the same stitch. Take the hook off the loop and insert into the top of the first dc, then go through the loop as well and pull it through the stitch. Chain 2, yarn over, then repeat this process for the following stitches.

Once you finish the row chain 2, then insert the hook into the first stitch of the first petal, then make a slip stitch and chain 1. Cut the yarn and pull the tail through.

Repeat the same steps until you have 4 daisies.

Now to make the granny square, grab your base yarn and make a slip stitch

Row 1

Insert hook into the first stitch of any petal and make a double crochet. Make another 2 dc into the same space. Chain 2, yarn over, insert hook into the same space and make another 3 dc. Yarn over, and do 3 hdc into the space after the dc. Make another 3 hdc into the space after that. Repeat these steps until you have completed the row.

Once at the end of the row, insert hook into the first stitch and slip stitch. Yarn over and chain 3.

Row 2

Go into the center of the corner and make 3 dc. Chain 2, insert hook back into the same space and dc 3 more. Dc 1 into the side stitches, only do 6 dc into the corners of the square. Repeat steps until you have 1 more stitch. For the last stitch do 2 dc into the stitch, then insert hook into the first dc of the corner, slip stitch, chain 1, and cut yarn.

Repeat these steps until you completed the 3 other squares.

Do not cut yarn once done with the last square Instead yarn over and insert into the back loop of another square and hdc. Repeat these steps, yarn over and insert hook into back loops of squares and hdc. Once two are connected, chain 2 and cut the yarn.

Repeat for the other 2 squares then repeat for the 2 panels you created.
